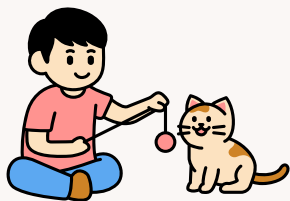
Nutrition and Feeding

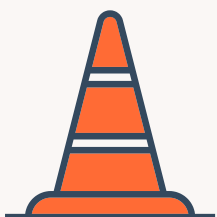
Health & Wellness
